

Some helpful information when you first arrive at the villa.

Wifi code is: villakalo1!

Water

Only use bottled water for drinking, the kettle and coffee machines. There is a high calcium content in the water but it is fine for brushing your teeth and cooking.

Supermarket

The nearest well stocked supermarket is called ARISTA. You will have past it on the way from the airport. It's a grey and red building. Go to the main road and turn left, it is approximately 2kms on the left.

Petrol Station:

The nearest petrol station of opposite ARISTA supermarket.

Air Conditioning:

Fans are provided free of charge and air conditioning is available in the bedrooms at a supplement of 50 euros per unit per week. Please let us know if you require air conditioning and we will arrange it for you.

Household waste

There is a dustbin at the back of the house. The rubbish bins do not get collected. The bins need to be emptied at the rubbish to the bins at the roadside. You will see the bins at the side of the road as you drive around. Could you please empty the bin on a daily basis to avoid pests and smells. Always use the bin liners which we will provide and please don't throw rubbish directly into the bin without it going in a liner. On your day of departure could you please ensure all bins inside the house and the one at the back had been emptied.

Internet TV

We have live TV which is streamed through the internet. We will show you how this works.

Barbeque

Could we just bring to your attention the possibilities of Forest fires due to the hot ashes of the barbeque. When you have finished with the barbeque, please can you kindly dampen down any hot coal that remains with water to avoid it blowing around and causing a fire. Could you please ensure that the coal is emptied on the day of your departure. In particularly hot/dry spells the local authorities may ban charcoal BBQ's due fire safety. We will inform you if this happens.

Outdoor lighting

There are plenty of outdoor lights to light up the property. Please use as required. When you go to bed and during the day could you please make sure all the outdoor lights are switched off.

Security when leaving the villa

Although the crime level is low in Corfu, we ask you to be mindful of the following: When leaving the villa please could you ensure that all doors and windows are locked, and the security alarm is switched ON. If the alarm is activated, we will be informed by SMS. If you activate the alarm in error, please let us know. It is not necessary to have the alarm turned on at nighttime when you are in bed.

The plants outside are watered by an irrigation system which usually comes on at about 10pm. You may hear them being watered.

The swimming pool and garden lights are on timers, and they will come on and off automatically. If you have a power cut, can you inform us so we can adjust the timers.

Takeaways

There are several takeaway grill houses and pizzerias on the road towards the airport, and in the close by village of Agios Ioannis. There is a takeaway pizzeria in Agios Ioannis called Nostra Pizzeria. (closed on Monday) They will deliver although it is only 5 minutes' drive away. Their phone number is: +30 26610 58328. Inform them of our location on google maps so they will be able to find you.

There is also "The Kitchen" Greek take away at the traffic lights at Agios Ioannis. They serve all different types of Greek home cooked food, and the menu changes daily. You will be able to find their daily menu on their Facebook page. They are usually open 10-5pm so order early to avoid disappointment.

Traditional Greek tavernas

Kostas Taverna is traditional Greek taverna nearby in the Villa of Agios Ioannis. They serve traditional Greek food in the quaint village square. It is 5 minutes' drive from the villa.

Ladokolla Taverna is in the village of Temploni. A lovely Greek taverna serving mouthwatering Meze and famous for its grills. All main courses are served in brown paper packages.

Spiros 97 Taverna is set in the heart of Vatos village. A roof top terrace shaded with grapevine. Serving appetizing Greek starters and traditional Greek and Corfiot dishes.

Pink Panther Taverna Just out of the village of Pelekas, keep left as you go past the church. Amazing views Overlooking Pelekas beach. Famous for stone baked pizza cooked in their pizza oven. Serves Greek and international cuisine.

Paprika Grill house. Local's favourite! You can dine inside or they do take away. They do spit roast chicken, Souvlak, Bifteki, Pitas and a variety of salads. All very tasty.

Pelekas village is a lovely traditional Greek village built into the hills. There are plenty of Greek tavernas for you to choose from. It will take you just under 15 minutes to drive to Pelekas.
